This institute is designed for those professionals and volunteers wishing to explore the exciting new science in youth development focused on the elements of hope, optimism and success and their application to a *Cultural Strategy* and practice in support of the *success of all children, NO EXCEPTIONS*.

What: A five day intensive training seminar and training of the trainers experience designed to provide the theoretical framework, science-including research and evaluation, strategies and practices.

When: Beginning the evening of Sunday, April 30, 2006 with graduation scheduled for Noon on Friday, May 5, 2006.
